

INFORMATION RELATED TO SALES TAX LETTERS SENT BY ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE

All businesses in Homewood and businesses that have paid sales tax to Homewood recently received a letter from the Alabama Department of Revenue concerning sales and use tax collection in an area referred to by them as a police jurisdiction.

This action does not affect any business transactions conducted within Homewood City limits. Police jurisdiction refers to areas OUTSIDE city limits (i.e. County) that cities can decide to provide services to and therefore tax. The City of Homewood does not collect tax in any area outside its city limits.

However, it is mandatory that all businesses WITHIN our city limits continue as always collecting 10% sales tax on all qualifying transactions.

We are sorry for any confusion relating to this and we did not know the letter was sent until after you received it nor were we asked to provide our input into it.
